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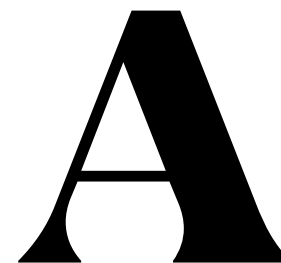

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SIGHT

Murcia is a city full of light, color, and life. Highlights include the **Murcia Cathedral**, built between 1394 and 1792, combines Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque and neoclassical styles, reflecting centuries of history and art. **The Real Casino de Murcia**, and the **Segura River**, where you can walk and enjoy the view. You can also visit **Plaza de las Flores** and the **Romea Theatre**.

Murcia also offers nature, with the Huerta, mountains like **Monteagudo Castle**, and viewpoints such as the **Santuario de la Fuensanta**. And don't miss its beaches, like **La Manga** and the **Mar Menor**.



HEARING

Close your eyes for a moment in Murcia. Feel the streets full of colour, flowers, and life. Among the laughter and movement, you hear the **Jota Murciana**, one of the region's most beloved traditions. Played with guitar, bandurria, and tambourine, its rhythm is lively and playful, danced in pairs with elegance and energy. This music is more than melody — it tells the story of Murcia's festivals, its agricultural roots, and the joy of families celebrating together.

TOUCH

Touch allows us to perceive contact, pressure, temperature and texture. Murcia, known as "**the vegetable garden of Europe**", stands out for its warm and sunny climate, with temperatures that reach up to 45 °C in summer and little rainfall. Its agriculture supplies Europe, especially in winter, with citrus fruits.

The Mar Menor, the largest salt lagoon in Europe, offers calm waters, beaches and mineral sludge with therapeutic properties.

In this experience, you can touch representative objects of each section and feel Murcia in a unique way.



SMELL

How does Murcia smell like? Murcia smells mainly of **citrus fruits** and the **sea**. In the huerta, near the Segura River, you can smell **oranges** and **lemons**, especially in spring. It is a fresh and natural smell.

On the coast, especially in the Mar Menor and the Mediterranean, the air smells **salty**.

These smells show the **connection between the land and the sea**, making Murcia a special and unforgettable place.

TASTE

Taste is one of the five senses, and through it we can discover a place. In Murcia, food reflects the sun, the land, and the sea.

With more than 300 days of sunshine, fruits and vegetables are sweet and full of flavor. Murcia is known as "**The Orchard of Europe**" and is also famous for **seafood** dishes like **Caldero**, as well as traditional foods such as **Zarangollo** and **Paparajotes**.
